

Step 3:

Share Your Thoughts on Organ Donation

Once you have made your decision, share your thoughts and wishes with your extended family, whānau or friends.

The next time you renew your driver licence, you will be required to indicate whether you would like to be a donor or not.

If you choose to be a donor, the word DONOR will be printed on your licence. This is an indication of your wishes only and not an organ donor register.

You still need to have a conversation about organ and tissue donation with your family/whānau and let them know your wishes. If you have done this, there is nothing else you need to do.
